

Responsible Service of Alcohol House Policy

This House Policy has been developed to ensure that all staff members that are employed at the Runaway Bay Seagulls Rugby League Club fully understand their obligations and responsibilities in relation to the Liquor Act 1992 and Liquor Regulation 2002.

The Runaway Bay Seagulls Rugby League Club is committed to ensuring that the service and supply of Liquor is conducted in such a way that all relevant harm minimisation techniques are considered and that the practice of RESPONSIBLE SERVICE OF ALCOHOL is followed at all times.

MINORS ARE NOT PERMITTED:

On the premises at any time unless accompanied by a responsible adult who is responsibly supervising them at all times whilst they are on the premises.
To purchase, consume or to be supplied alcohol at any time.
In any areas set aside for gambling at any time.
On the premises at any time after 10pm.

UNDULY INTOXICATED & DISORDERLY PATRONS:

Will be refused entry to any and all areas of the premises.
Will be refused service and removed from the premises as soon as possible.
Will be offered a taxi or directed to the nearest taxi rank if required.
Any persons that are argumentative, or who are deemed to be behaving indecently, disorderly or offensively will be refused service and removed from the premises as soon as possible.
Any persons that are deemed to be engaging in sexual harassment, assault or discriminatory behaviors towards patrons or staff will be refused service and removed from the premises as soon as possible.

OUR STAFF ARE:

Fully aware of the conditions of the Liquor Licence and the premises House Policy.
Required to successfully complete an accredited Responsible Service of Alcohol(RSA) Course within

one month of commencing employment.
Committed to ensuring that the service and supply of liquor is conducted in such a way that all relevant harm minimisation techniques are considered.
Aware of their responsibilities in relation to "duty of care" including drink spiking, harassment and violence issues.
Required to request any patron that is not accompanied by a responsible adult that visibly appears (in their opinion) to be under the age of 25 years to provide an acceptable form of identification prior to being allowed entry, being served or allowed to consume alcohol.
Fully supported by Management in relation to the checking of identification.
Required to record any and all incidents in the RSA Incident Register.
Fully aware of fire and emergency evacuation plans.

THIS VENUE:

Respects our neighbours and requires that our patrons and staff do so also.
Will not engage in any promotion or activity that may encourage rapid or excessive consumption of alcohol at any time.
Operates CCTV throughout the Runaway Bay Seagulls Rugby League Club that captures and records images for a minimum of 14 days.
Will display a dress standard as part of the conditions of entry to the premises.
